COST EFFECTIVE

A minimally invasive approach allows surgeons to operate through a small opening that minimizes tissue damage and allows for quicker recovery.



HIGH SATISFACTION RATE

Surgery Center patients report a 92% satisfaction rate, whereas hospitals only report 70% of patients would recommend the hospital to a friend or family member.

The satisfaction rate of surgery centers is 22% HIGHER than hospitals.



ONE BILL
